

Nancy Atlas' NEW CD "It Ain't That Way Now"

The Nancy Atlas Project released their latest CD, "It Ain't That Way Now", in August of this year. This is the 5th album Nancy Atlas has released under her own label, Neptuna Records. With 13 original songs written by Atlas and one killer cover of The Rolling Stone's "Wild Horses", with guest violinist, Randi Fishenfeld. I must say it's the best one yet! Nancy's own thoughts on the album are, "I can still listen to it after 2,000 times so that's a good sign. I think this album rocks. I wrote these songs over a four-year period and I am just so happy that they have been recorded with sonic loving by Johnny Blood. I think it's an album with different moods and flavors but that when you listen to it on a whole it is hopefully like taking a little road trip"

Nancy's powerful songwriting and vocal abilities combine in such a way that grabs your attention and touches you deep down. She doesn't just sing about something, she tells a story. There is a truth and honesty to her words that people can easily relate to. Track 5 titled "East End Run" is a perfect example of this. A tribute to Montauk, this song will give you chills as Atlas takes you on a tour along the tracks from Lazy Point to all the best places in Montauk. Another notable track is "Love You From The Sky"; a touching ballad co-written with Cashus Lee Muse, her four-year-old son. A very pretty song that might bring a tear or two to your eyes. And of course there are good time rockers like "Last Call For Alcohol" that you just have to dance to. My personal favorite, "Montanita" is not only a rocking tune but quite impressive because it's in Spanish. Whether you speak Spanish or not, you can't help but sing along. This album has something for everyone on it. It's classic Nancy and the boys in the band are as tight and dynamic as ever.
